

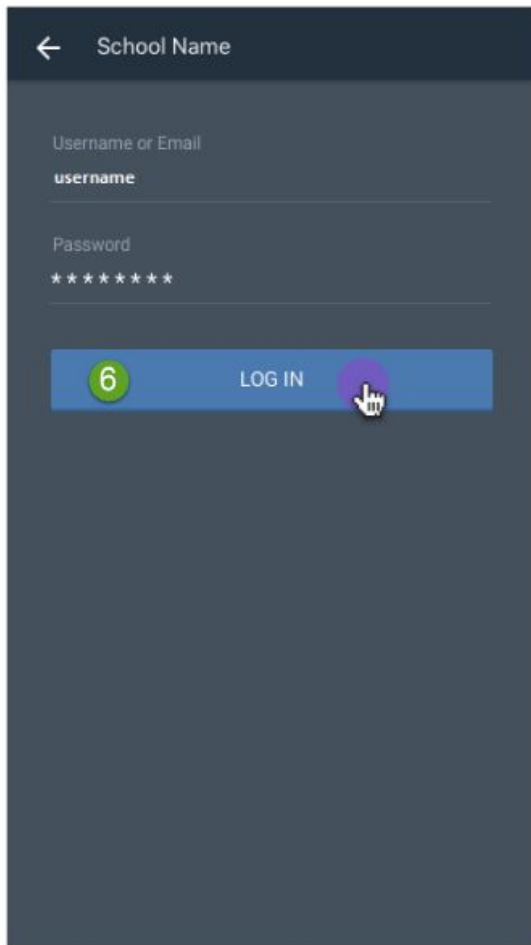


Logging on to the Schoolology iOS and Android Apps

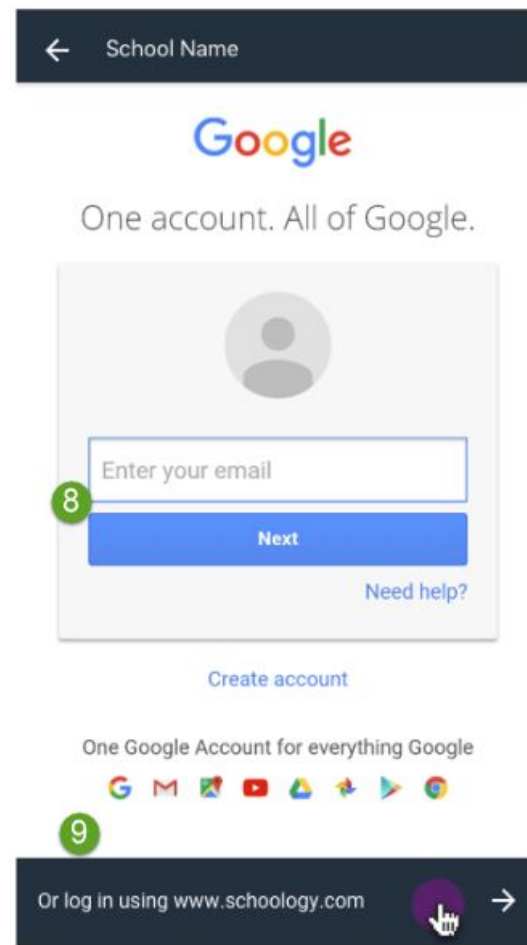
Note to K-12 System Admins: If you do not currently include parents in the authentication service at your school, they must select Log in through app.schoolology.com (step 2 below) when logging into the mobile app. If you do include parents in your SSO, parents/guardians will follow the below steps and select the school.

Beginning in January, users of both the Schoolology iOS and Android mobile apps will experience a new, more streamlined login flow.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tap into the Find your school or domain field to search for your organization. <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Tap CONTINUE TO SCHOOLLOGY to log in through app.schoolology.com using your email/username and password combination. Use this option if you have a basic account, for example, or if you are not included in your organization's Single-Sign On. Go to step 6 if you choose this option. 		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Use the keyboard to enter the name of your school or organization. As you type, matching choices populate in the list. 5. Tap the name of your organization when it displays.


6. Enter your login credentials and tap **LOG IN**.
7. If your school or organization authenticates users with Single-Sign On, the SSO login screen displays automatically.



8. For example, if your organization uses Google SSO, you are brought to the Google sign in screen. Enter your Google credentials to sign in to Schoolology.

Note: Your organization's preferred login screen displays automatically for each subsequent login from the device. For example, if your school shares devices, the Google login screen displays automatically for the next student who logs in on the device.

9. You can also tap the link at the bottom to use your email and password combination to log in.



10. The next time someone opens the Schoolology app on the mobile device, the same school or organization displays as the default, including your SSO screen if applicable. This makes it easier to log in on your own device, and is also useful if your school uses shared devices.

11. To change the school or organization to log into, tap the **Log in through your School** field and begin typing the new name. Matching choices populate as you type.
