Mobile App	Browser
Students can participate in all learning activities.	Students can easily use the browser as well.
Teachers can post updates, discussions and assignments, grade and leave comments, but <i>cannot</i> organize materials or add more advanced materials.	Teachers use the browser as their primary tool for creating and organizing materials and setting up their Gradebook.
Grade assignments and tests.	Grade anything (including discussions).
Use Apple's "Open In" feature to add resources to Schoology that were created in other iPad apps.	Upload files from your computer. Use your Webcam to add video and photos to Media Albums, Discussions, Assignments, and Updates.
Students make assignment submissions using Schoology, iPad Camera, Google Drive, or using "Open In" from other iPad apps.	Students make assignment submissions using Schoology, their Webcam, Google Drive, or uploading from their hard drive.
Use your iPad Camera or the iPad gallery to add videos and photos to Media Albums, Discussions, Assignments, and Updates.	Use webcams to add videos and photos to media albums, discussions, assignments, and updates.
Teachers do not have access to any advanced material features.	Teachers access "advanced" features like <i>Individually Assign</i> .
